

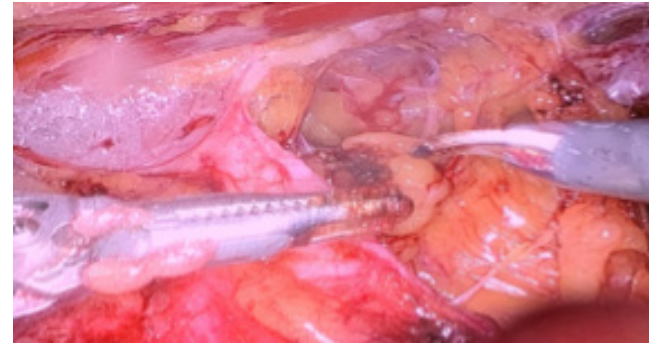
eTEP in Bucharest with Dr. Victor Radu

When I found out about the Swiss Hernia Days fellowship I was really excited since over the last few months I had become very interested in the eTEP technique. Is there a better way as to learn anything new from an expert such as Victor Radu?



Since Victor is working in a private hospital and patients are referred to him personally it was up to the very last week uncertain if there would enough suitable surgeries for the planned week. But fortunately there were.

Together with me a fellow from the European Hernia society started her fellowship with Victor and by the end of the week surgeons from Turkey joined in as well. So I had the chance to discuss cases and medical structures with professionals from different countries.



Victor showed us different hernia surgeries, both robotic and laparoscopic. In each surgery he explained where the difficulties are and how to come across them. We could closely observe every step and learn about all these small little details that come with a lot of practice.

It was very impressive to see how fast, efficient and safe an eTEP can be performed and how well the patients are even after an extended procedure and how little pain they have.
